

Recruiting: a year-round process

- Think outside the box! Do something that has never been done before.
 - o Buy in. "Why should I join" have a plan for the year. "What does future success look like"
- Pass out popsicles & meeting invitation at band camp.
- Attend a freshman class meeting and give invitations
- Student organizations fair
- Network with local high school music educators. Have an informational meeting. "A Day in the Life of a Music Ed. Major"
- Have a presence at prospective music major day/audition. Flyers, lounge for parents (collect student contact information from parents), half sheet "5 tips to have a better audition"
- Talk to your professor about making membership and meeting attendance mandatory for Music Ed classes
- Mixer with other music organizations on campus PMA, SAI, ACDA, etc.
- Incentivize membership in some way. Top fundraiser gets free dues next year.

The first meeting: only 1/3 of the people you invite will come

- Introduction of officers
- Introduction of faculty advisor and chair of the music department
- Outline for the year
- BRIEF business meeting
- Fun activity capture the flag on the quad, board games, dance party in the band room
 - Do something other than make music.
- Everyone goes out for dinner together after

Professional Development: Forming your personal PLC: "MUED Talks"

- Fall PD Day invite local teachers and students from close universities to attend, faculty members from all attending universities to speak, invite local district arts supervisor or NAfME National President to be Keynote speaker, host a networking lunch, provide certificates of professional development recognition for all attendees.
- Spring Teacher Licensure Exam Prep Day invite students from close universities to attend, everyone takes a practice Teacher Licensure Exam in the morning, after lunch once scores are tallied, attendees break off into groups with faculty members (choir/band directors, music ed. faculty, etc.) to work on content they missed.
- NAfME Academy 20 minutes of each chapter meeting should be professional development.
- Music organization PD mixer Invite super star teacher to talk about a topic that is relevant to all music educators: professionalism, classroom management, business tip for music educators, applying and interviewing for jobs, etc. invite PMA, SAI, ACDA, Etc.
- Attending MEA conference
- Sending president/president elect to NAfME's Collegiate Advocacy Summit

Communication: Connections, Connections, Connections.

- ALWAYS collect contact information: name, email, cell number, major etc. and keep a running list.
- Use free platform for communications: ConstantContact, Remind, Social Media, etc.

- Communicate often, but don't be annoying.
- Communicate with alumni for fundraising purposes.

Fundraising:

- What is our goal? Why are we fundraising?
 - o Donations
 - o Professional Development
 - o Banquet
- Know where the money is going.
 - o 75% to the chapter
 - o 10% to a local music teacher
 - o 10% to a music department scholarship program
 - o 5% to the Give A Note Foundation
