Dear Teachers,

We are pleased to announce that Stissing Mountain Jr./Sr. High School in Pine Plains will be the North site for the 2024 NYSSMA Zone 10 Solo Festival. This solo festival is open to all school districts in Zone 10.

The festival will take place on Friday and Saturday May 3 and 4 at Stissing Mountain High School and will include levels 1-6 and All-State for woodwinds, brass, percussion, strings, piano, and voice. There will not be jazz solos at this site.

**REGISTRATION:** Registration for this festival is now open on Da Capo Music Festivals www.dacapomusicfestivals.com. If you are unfamiliar with DaCapo, please visit https://tinyurl.com/54cau58b for assistance (please do not email the Da Capo webmaster with festival-specific questions). The registration deadline for the festival is March 22, 2024. Late registrations will not be accepted!

Before registering your students, please do everything you can to eliminate the need for scheduling changes. Be sure your students have checked their own calendars before requesting times, and have doubled-checked with their accompanists. We will do our best to honor requested times, but please make it clear to your students that requested times are not guaranteed. Traditionally, Friday is very popular for Zone 10 festivals, so students must keep both Friday and Saturday open.

**PAYMENT:** Please note that the NYSSMA fees for each audition are as follows:

Levels I-IV = \$16 Levels V & VI = \$24 All-State = \$30

Levels I-IV Piano = \$22 Level V&VI Piano = \$30

proper forms are mailed to us in advance of the deadline. Audition times are assigned on a "first come, first-served" basis upon receipt of registrations and payments.

**ACCOMPANISTS:** When registering, please include the accompanist's full name for each accompanied solo. Many accompanists work with students from multiple districts, and the schedule must be created according to their availability. Pianos for accompaniment will only be available for voice and All State students. Please do not bring your own keyboard to accompany students in another room.

## **OTHER IMPORTANT REMINDERS:**

- Students that plan to use pre-recorded accompaniment MUST BRING THEIR OWN SPEAKERS OR CD PLAYER. No speakers will be provided onsite.
- Please make certain that you and your students make music selections based on NYSSMA Manual Edition 33 (effective July 2022, white pages/green tabs). For more information, please see https://www.nyssma.org/committees/manual/. Please be aware of rule changes (specifically regarding playing the same solo on two different instruments) and the scales and sight-reading required for each level.
- A xylophone, timpani and bass drum are the only percussion instruments available for percussion auditions. All other percussion equipment must be supplied by the student or teacher (cymbals, triangle and tambourine will be supplied for All-State sight-reading only).
- All- State forms are no longer mailed to NYSSMA. They should be completed on- line by the registration deadline. The All-State online recommendation form is now open.
