Regular Orientation** – for applicants who are not current NYSSMA adjudicators. A bachelor's degree in music and a minimum of one year full-time teaching experience (prior to 2024-25 school year) is required.

Second Area Orientation – Candidate must be a NYSSMA adjudicator with a minimum of two festival seasons experience and a minimum of four judging assignments in their primary area.

All-State Orientation – Candidate must be a NYSSMA adjudicator with a minimum of **four** festival seasons experience and a minimum of **eight** judging assignments in their primary area. <u>This requirement may be waived for Inst. and Vocal Jazz.</u> Major Organizations Orientation – Candidate must be a NYSSMA adjudicator with a minimum of three festival seasons

Major Organizations Orientation – Candidate must be a NYSSMA adjudicator with a minimum of three festival seasons experience and a minimum of six judging assignments in their primary area. In addition, a minimum of eight (8) years of successful teaching/conducting experience, along with participation in a minimum of five (5) M.O. Festivals or comparable events, is required. **Regular adjudicators are required to demonstrate knowledge on all instruments in their area of orientation.
