



Books




To access the vocal book list, click on the book tab in your main dashboard. This list can then be sorted by any of the column headers by clicking on those headings (title, composers, publisher, voice parts).




If you click on the name of any book, it will bring you to a new page showing what solos can be utilized from each book. Again, these can be sorted by the headings of each column.




Bookmarks



First, click on the sections tab to locate the section you want to bookmark.




In the search bar, type what instrumentation you are looking for and then click on the bookmark in the lower right hand corner of the tab. When selected, it will change from clear to filled in.




To access bookmarks when you login, go to your dashboard and click in the upper right hand corner. To change bookmarks, click on "manage bookmarks."

Composers




Clicking on the composers tab will bring up a list of composers in the manual. You can use the search bar for specific composers and then click on each composer to show what titles are available in the manual for them.




Please note that "popular" composers may be listed more than once depending on section editing and will have different material listed under each heading.

Filters




Each section of the manual has further sorting capabilities when you use the filter button on the left hand side.




This filtering is extremely helpful when looking for specific All-State ranges. For more information on any solo, click on the expansion arrow.

Instrument Specific Rules




