NEW THIS YEAR

- → Registration fees have increased to \$30 per student
- → Vocal Jazz Ensemble is here! A number of schedule changes have been made to accommodate the new ensemble -
 - ◆ Friday's rehearsal runs 2:00 PM to 7:30 PM
 - ◆ Concerts on Saturday are now:
 - 12:00 PM Concert #1 Jazz Ensemble
 - 1:00 PM Concert #2 Vocal Jazz, Treble Choir, Mixed Choir
 - 3:30 PM Concert #3 String Orch, Symphony Orch, Band

Registration fees

- → Print your teacher or district invoice from DaCapo and begin processing payment immediately.
- → Your district is responsible for the \$30 per student registration fee for all students accepted, whether or not they participate. DO NOT CROSS STUDENTS OFF YOUR INVOICE. DO NOT CHANGE THE AMOUNT OF THE INVOICE.
- → Alternates DO NOT pay the registration fee, even if they get placed in an ensemble.
- → Registration payments are due PRIOR TO THE FESTIVAL.
- → Checks are to be made payable to "NYSSMA" and mailed to Kevin Duncan at Lewiston-Porter HS, 4061 Creek Rd, Youngstown NY 14174.

PLEASE HELP...

- → JH and SH invoices are separate on DaCapo. *DO NOT combine JH and SH purchase orders or payments.* Keep them separate.
- → Be sure your business office does not combine AAS payments with conference all-state payments.
- → <u>DO NOT LET YOUR BUSINESS OFFICE MAIL THE CHECK TO NYSSMA.</u> Please, please, please triple check that your SH fees are sent to Kevin Duncan at Lewiston-Porter HS and JH fees are sent to Jared Burch at Pioneer.
- → For districts that pay through **BOCES** or use **BOCES** Arts in Education funds
 - create separate PO's for JH and SH AAS;
 - instruct BOCES to <u>include your district's name on the PO and check memo line</u>, otherwise we have no idea what district the payment is from;
 - clearly instruct BOCES to mail the check to the chairperson, not to NYSSMA.

Covid Protocol

- → Masking, proof of vaccination, distancing, or other measures are NOT REQUIRED of students, teachers, or audience members at the festival or concerts.
- → If a student has a fever or feels ill in any way, they should stay home.

Arrival & Registration

- → Plan to arrive on campus no earlier than 1:30.
- → Students can get dropped off in the clock tower loop and proceed directly to their rehearsal spaces.
- → A designated chaperone from each district must check in at the registration desk located in Mason Hall by Rausch recital hall where the Jazz Ensemble will rehearse.
- → A chaperone or teacher from each school must be available at all times in case of emergency. Chaperones must sign in at the registration table both days and leave a cell phone number.
- → At the registration table you can pick up meal tickets, pay for meal tickets, and pay registration fees. You can also purchase additional lunch tickets.

Instruments, Music, and Equipment

- → <u>ALL band and symphony wind players MUST bring a wire music stand.</u> We are always short on music stands, especially for those players who are one-on-a-stand.
- → <u>Choral and Vocal Jazz students must bring a black music folder</u> for use in rehearsals and the concert.
- → Large instruments can be stored overnight in the Mason rehearsal rooms.
- → Cello and bass students must use a rockstop on the hardwood rehearsal and stage floors.
- → All music is to be returned at the conclusion of the concert. If music is missing or is found to be damaged, the ensemble chairperson will contact the student's music teacher to resolve the situation. Students are financially responsible for missing or damaged music.

Meals

- → Students are able to bring their own snacks and meals.
- → Friday dinner and/or Saturday lunch are available for purchase via pre-order for \$15. Orders can only be placed by teachers by using the online order form. See the "Meal Orders" page below for more details.
- → Because the SUNY Fredonia campus will be closing for Thanksgiving break, campus food options are limited. We cannot guarantee that Tim Hortons, Starbucks, and other campus restaurants will be open.
- → We don't want any kids to go hungry and not eat. If a student doesn't have food and does not have a meal ticket on Saturday, they can sign in through the meal line and we'll catch up on billing later on.

Concert Information

- → There are no covid restrictions for audience members attending the concert. Masks for audience members are optional, not required.
- → Students must arrive in concert dress on Saturday. There will not be time or space for students to change into concert dress on Saturday.
- → The concerts on Saturday, November 23rd will take place as follows
 - ◆ 12:00 PM Jazz Ensemble in Rosch Recital Hall (Mason Hall)
 - ◆ 1:00 PM Vocal Jazz, Treble Chorus, Mixed Chorus in King Concert Hall
 - ◆ 3:30PM String Orchestra, Symphony Orchestra, Band in King Concert Hall
- → Tickets for parents/guests will be sold through the campus ticket office. *Please encourage and remind your students to purchase tickets for their families during their Friday rehearsal breaks.*
- → Parents who attend more than one concert can use their ticket for all of the concerts. They do NOT need to purchase separate tickets for each concert.
- → Concert doors will open for seating 30 minutes before each performance.
- → Audience members may stay for all concerts at no additional charge.

Area All-State Concert Dress

All students participating in Area All-State are expected to abide by basic concert dress requirements to maintain a consistent and professional look to our ensembles.

STUDENTS WHO ARE NOT IN COMPLIANCE WITH THESE DRESS REQUIREMENTS MAY NOT BE ALLOWED TO PERFORM IN THE CONCERT

Band, String Orchestra, Symphony Orchestra -

Boys

- solid black pants and jacket
- long-sleeve white dress shirt
- long dark tie or bowtie
- black socks and dress shoes

Girls

- black attire from shoulders to heels
- low or flat black dress shoes
- dresses used for school concerts are acceptable if they meet the above criteria

Jazz Ensemble and Vocal Jazz - all black

Boys

- solid black pants (no jacket)
- long-sleeve black dress shirt
- long dark tie
- black socks and shoes

Girls

- black attire from shoulders to heels
- low or flat black dress shoes
- dresses used for school concerts are acceptable if they meet the above criteria

Treble Choir and Mixed Choir - all black

Boys

- solid black pants
- long-sleeve black dress shirt
- black socks and shoes
- no jacket or necktie

Girls

- black attire from shoulders to heels
- low or flat black dress shoes
- dresses used for school concerts are acceptable if they meet the above criteria

ATTENTION ALL PERFORMERS:

Skirts that are above the knee must be worn with solid black stockings. Girls who will perform seated must wear bottoms that fall **below the knee while seated**.

The following items are absolutely prohibited:

- Flip-flops or high heeled shoes
- Bare shoulders or spaghetti straps
- Bare midriff
- Patterned or fishnet stockings
- Skirts or dresses that are revealing or have a slit
