

Currently, in his 20th year of teaching at Amherst Central High School, Justin T. Pomietlarz serves as Director of Choral Activities and the Producer/Music Director of the Amherst Operetta Association. He is a graduate of SUNY Fredonia '97 (Music Education/Piano Performance) and '04 (Choral Conducting/Piano Performance). Prior to teaching at Amherst, Mr. Pomietlarz taught at Hauppauge H.S., L.I. (Suffolk Co.), Marion Jr./Sr. H.S. (Wayne Co.) and Rochester C.S.D. (Monroe Co.).

He was the recipient of the 2018 BPO/ECMEA "Outstanding Music Educator of the Year Award," and previously was recognized as the



Under his direction, the Amherst Concert Chorale has appeared at Carnegie Hall with National Concerts, MidAmerica Productions and Choirs of America, and locally with the Buffalo Philharmonic Orchestra, the Western New York Chamber Orchestra, the Camerata di Sant' Antonio, the Orchard Park Symphony and the Amherst Symphony Orchestras.

Justin and his wife Kristen also serve as co-Music Directors, Organist-Choirmaster of the historic Holy Trinity Lutheran Church in downtown Buffalo, where he conducts the semi-professional Chancel Choir, the Chapel Choir and oversees the Concert and Youth Choir programs. He resides with his wife Kristen, and daughter Lillian in Parkside, Buffalo.

## **JAMES IEDA-String Orchestra**

Violinist James Ieda hails from Angola NY, currently resides in Clarence with his wife and musical children. A Suzuki student from the age of 3, James was raised and coached by his music teaching parents Jim and Annette. James received a Bachelor's Degree in Music Performance and Education from SUNY at Potsdam, and a Master's Degree from SUNY at Fredonia in Violin Performance. With various performing groups, James has played concerts in Europe and Russia.

In 1996 James became the Director of the Secondary Strings Orchestra and a tutor at the St. Lucia School of Music. As a teacher in St. Lucia, James grew the program, arranged local folk songs for the orchestra, and his time culminated with a performance for Nelson Mandela. As a performer on the island, James worked at Sandals, Wyndham Morgan Bay, and The Royal St. Lucian to name a few. He was the violinist in the Calypso finals in 1997 with artist Tricky.

After leaving St. Lucia, Mr. Ieda took a job teaching elementary strings in Clarence NY; 1999 to the present. He's taught and coached chamber music at summer camps, done workshops locally and abroad, and returned to St. Lucia in 2018 to teach a summer music camp with his family. As a performer, James is the Concertmaster of a local professional orchestra, a local community orchestra and a section player in a local professional orchestra. He frequently performs weddings and other local gigs as a freelance violinist. Notable performances include playing with Phish, Kansas, Jackie Evancho, Frank Sinatra Jr., Hans Zimmer, Weird Al, The Eagles, and Stevie Wonder to name a few. He is a founding member of Queen City Strings, a local string quartet that plays professionally and pro bono.

In his free time, James is an avid Hobie 16 sailor, crew on a 31' Columbia sailboat, hunter, snowboarder, and Jeeper. He looks forward to continuing his travels, performing with his family, and spreading the gospel of music around the world.

For the past twenty-five years, Mr. Ersing has served as Choral and Drama Director at West Seneca West Senior High School, where he directs six choral ensembles and the school's musical productions. He has been invited to conduct numerous county and Area All-State choirs



throughout Western New York and recently concluded eighteen years as chair and co-chair of the ECMEA Vocal Jazz program.
